Trying to get pregnant?

Use this guide to see if you might need fertility treatment.

Remember the 1/3 Rule

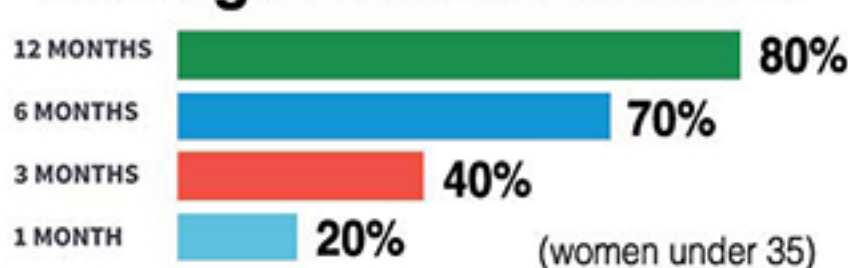
Causes of infertility: 1/3 due to male factor, 1/3 female, 1/3 both.

Great, keep trying.

80% of couples will get pregnant within one year of trying at this age.

For women under 35 years old, infertility is defined as trying to get pregnant for more than one year.

See a fertility specialist:

For women age 35 or older, infertility is defined as trying to get pregnant for more than six months.

Great, keep trying.

Some fertile couples will get pregnant within six months of trying at this age.



Fertility Treatments



Are you MALE or FEMALE?

Male

1 TESTING

Male factor infertility can be caused by a number of potential factors. You may need fertility treatment if you have experienced one of the following:

- Impotence
- Prior surgery on the penis or testes
- Testicle trauma
- History of mumps in adulthood
- Previous cancer treatments such as chemotherapy or radiation



These are not always the sole factors of infertility. To determine if you have male factor infertility, meet with a specialist.

COMMON TESTS

- Physical exam
- Semen analysis
- Hormone levels
- Genetic evaluation
- Ultrasound

Female

1 TESTING

Female infertility can be caused by a number of potential factors. You may need fertility treatment if you have one of the following symptoms or conditions:

- History of irregular menstrual cycles
- Known or suspected problems with the fallopian tubes or uterus
- Other problems such as endometriosis or fibroids



These are not always the sole factors of infertility. To determine if you have female factor infertility, meet with a specialist.

COMMON TESTS

- Physical exam
- Pelvic ultrasound
- Ovarian reserve
- HSG
- Hormone levels

2 DIAGNOSIS

Possible causes of male infertility that can be diagnosed through testing:

- Low semen value
- Low sperm count and/or motility
- Male hormone imbalance
- Genetic abnormalities that can affect sperm production
- Anatomic issues
- Retrograde ejaculation
- Impotence



2 DIAGNOSIS

Possible causes of female infertility that can be diagnosed through testing:

- Anovulation
- Blocked or damaged fallopian tubes
- Ovarian failure
- Polycystic ovary syndrome
- Uterine fibroids
- Uterine polyps
- Endometriosis
- Unexplained infertility



3 FERTILITY TREATMENT

There are many potential options for successfully treating infertility.

POTENTIAL TREATMENTS TO HELP YOU REACH SUCCESSFUL PREGNANCY:

- Sperm retrieval
- Corrective surgery
- Medications



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TREATMENTS FOR MALES & FEMALES

- Lifestyle changes such as a healthy diet and weight loss
- IVF with intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI)
 - Ovulation inducing medications
 - Intrauterine insemination (IUI)
 - In vitro fertilization (IVF)
 - Donor egg or sperm with IVF
